- Aluminum foil
- Batteries
- Battery-operated TV and radio
- Bleach
- Can opener
- Carbon-monoxide detector (if you're using a generator)
- Chain saw (for tree debris)
- Coolers
- Disinfectant
- Duct tape
- Extension cords (for generators)
- Feminine supplies
- Flashlight
- Fire extinguisher
- First-aid kit
- Fix-a-flat
- Frozen gel packs
- Gas cans
- Generator (a 1,500-watt generator cost roughly \$400)
- Kid supplies, including books, a battery-operated DVD player and games
- Map of your state/general area (for evacuation routes)
- Matches
- Nonperishable food to last three days
- Paper cups, plates and plastic utensils
- Plastic bucket with tight lid
- Plastic storage containers
- Pliers
- Rain gear
- Rubber boots (in case it floods)
- Sandbags (for flooding)
- Soap and toiletries
- Tarps or plastic sheeting (to protect your stuff if your roof is blown off)
- Toilet paper
- Trash bags (for cleanup)
- Utility knife
- Water
- Whistle
- Work gloves
